Congress must strengthen and protect the Postal Service during the COVID-19 crisis

FAMILY FIRST CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ACT (FFCRA)

CODES FOR ABSENCES DUE TO COVID

Code 086-19 - CCAs under M-01911 are permitted to use up to **80 hours of paid leave** in conjunction with the COVID-19 pandemic. Paid leave must be requested on this (**M-01911 has been extended through July 17, 2020.**)

PS Form 3971, write Other and LC19 in the space provided.

FAMILY FIRST CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE ACT (FFCRA)

1. **Code 077-19** - **80 hours** of paid sick leave at 100% of employee's regular rate of pay. **Qualifying reasons 1, 2, 3.** Federal employees are eligible for up to two weeks of fully or partially paid sick leave for COVID-19 related reasons. These provisions apply from April 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020.

PS Form 3971, write FFCRA and Emergency Paid Sick Leave - Self

2. **Code 081-19** - **80 hours** of paid sick leave at **two-thirds** of employee's regular rate of pay. **Qualifying reason number 4, 5, 6.** Also, **qualifying reason number 5** can be substituted for the first two weeks of unpaid leave at **two-thirds** of their regular rate of pay for FMLA expansion. These provisions apply from April 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020.

PS Form 3971, write FFCRA and Emergency Paid Sick Leave - Other

3. **Code 066-18** - **10 weeks** of paid expanded FMLA at **two-thirds** of employee's regular rate of pay. **Qualifying reason 5.** Federal employees who are covered under Title I of FMLA and have been employed for at least 30 days prior to the leave request. These provisions apply from April 1, 2020, through December 31, 2020.
